
Happy 100th Centennial Birthday, Lewiston Fire Company #1!

Volunteers in 1914 had no equipment, started "Bucket Brigade" to protect life and property

A hundred years ago, Lewistonians had only themselves and neighbors to help put out fires. The fire company was formed in 1914 as a bucket brigade. The first group of volunteers consisted of 25 men. Each man was required to keep two canvas buckets in a convenient place, so they could respond as quickly as possible when

the Presbyterian Church bell rang alerting them to a fire.

1934 saw tremendous growth in the fire company with the purchase of additional hose and new equipment. An incredible number of volunteers - 53! - joined the company that year. During World War II, the fire company numbers were greatly reduced while the firemen served their country. The fire company contributed further to the cause by participating in scrap metal and clothing drives and contributing to blood banks. The current fire hall on North Sixth Street was built in 1955, expanded in 1965, and expanded again in 2013.



"Hose Reel" Acquired in 1916

You can see the proud volunteer firemen standing in front of the Frontier House, next to their new "hose reel" in 1916 - the Fire Company's first apparatus.



Here is the fire company's pride and joy -- the 1937 Ward LaFrance pumper which is still part of the fleet. Like the hose reel above, this photo was taken in front of the Frontier House during a parade. Emerson Walker is driving. It was recently restored by the volunteer firemen.

First Fire Hall on Center Street, Next to Today's Brio's

The first fire hall was built in 1927. It had one bay and a siren on the roof. It was located at 446 Center Street, between today's Brio Pizzeria and the Frontier House. Fred Perrigo was the first Fire Chief.

1914 Fire bucket brigade formed

1916 First equipment bought

1917 Official incorporation by the Village Board of Trustees

1927 First fire hall built on Center Street

1934 First Fireman's Field Day

1955 First ambulance purchased

1955 Cornerstone laid fire hall on N. 6th St.

1969 Purchase of tone generator – only volunteer fire company in Niagara County to dispatch its own calls

1976 Purchase of Swann Road property to serve as a satellite hall for eastern portion of the district

1982 Purchase of Jaws of Life – a gift from the Ladies' Auxiliary
