Once-in-a-Lifetime Total Solar Eclipse Appears on April 8, 2024

Lewiston to Commemorate a "Step Back in Time"

Center Street will transform into a 19th Century "Frontier Village"

Unless you were born before 1925, the total solar eclipse that will appear in Lewiston and Western New York on April 8, 2024, will be a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Tens of thousands of people from around the world will converge on our region to experience a rare natural phenomenon when the moon blocks the sun's rays. For 2-1/2 hours on the afternoon of Monday, April 8, Center Street will be shrouded in partial or total darkness. Community leaders and volunteers are making plans to celebrate this event by turning Lewiston into a Frontier Village.

Eclipse Event Highlights

Volunteer event planners are working to provide Lewiston residents and visitors a unique experience, without upstaging nature's amazing show.

- 19th Century demonstrations will portray a "living history" Frontier Village.
- Street lighting will be turned off, and businesses will be encouraged to turn off interior and exterior lighting during "totality." The only light will be from candles.
- Church bells will be ringing before and after totality.
- A new play, Phantoms of the Opera Hall, will be presented at the Opera Hall, 732 Center Street, on April 5 & 6 at 7pm, and April 7 at 2pm. Meet the phantoms whose stories were shaped by the moon! For reservations email: PhantomsoftheOperaHall@gmail.com

Eclipse Tips


- If you are making hotel, restaurant or travel reservations for friends and family, make them early.
